

The Cleghorn War & Memory Study Tour

8-21 July 2012



High School teachers, BEd and MEd candidates are invited to apply for a study tour examining the Canadian battlefields and memorials of the Great War in Belgium and France as well as the Second World War in Dieppe and Normandy.

Participants may register for academic credit at the Master's or senior undergraduate level or obtain a non-credit certificate. A maximum of 18 participants will be selected. Each will receive a bursary sufficient to cover all accommodation, travel and instruction costs while in Europe. Fees for course credit, travel to and from Europe, the cost of some meals and incidentals are the responsibility of the participant.
