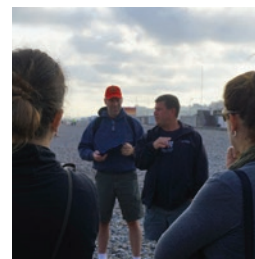
The Juno Beach Centre Association offers Canadian history teachers the opportunity to tour First and Second World War battlefields in France, and participate in the Juno Beach Centre's Summer Institute on the historic landing beaches of Normandy, France.

Educators from across Canada now have the opportunity to apply to take part in our **2015 professional development program**. Participants will travel to Northern France via Paris to gain first-hand knowledge of Canada's participation in the First and Second World Wars. The **10-day tour** includes visits to Canadian battlefields at **Vimy Ridge, Beaumont-Hamel, the D-Day landing beaches, the Falaise Gap**, and of course, spend time at the **Juno Beach Centre!**
