The online submission system for proposals for the 2012 AERA Annual Meeting opens on JUNE 1st and will close on JULY 22nd, 2011. There will be no extensions to the deadline this year. Please be sure to indicate at least two modes of presentation for your submissions (e.g., poster and paper). The overall allotment of paper sessions across AERA has decreased. This will result in an increased use of other presentation modes, such as roundtables and posters. In reading the Call for Submissions, please note the continued emphasis on providing warranted conclusions with data in the proposal, even if they are preliminary. Therefore, submissions must be in the form of a narrative paper, whether it is in progress or final (an abstract or a proposal to write a paper will not be considered).

A paper or session submission may be submitted only to a single committee, division, or SIG, and an individual may not appear as first author on more than two submissions. [See the AERA Call for Submissions page for more detailed proposal criteria.](#)
