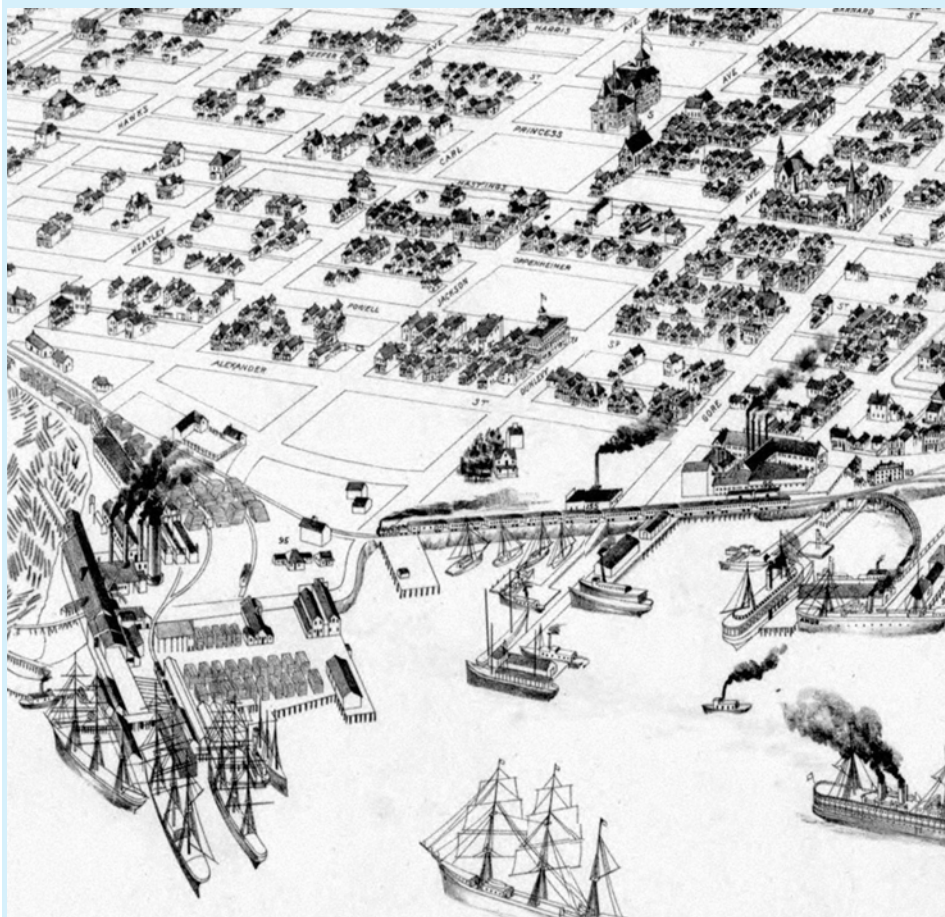


Approaching the Past
